Kids 'N Care provides a team of **Registered Nurse Care Coordinators** to ensure the child's medical, dental and mental health needs are met. The Nurse Care Coordinator team partners with Family Support Services to streamline and coordinate the complex health care services a foster child receives.

Together, we give foster children and their families the tools and information they need to help the child receive the best medical care possible.

» What is a Medical Home?

A Medical Home is a way to provide integral health care services as part of Northeast Florida's child welfare system of care. Children and their families who have medical homes receive the care that is needed from a pediatrician and nurse care coordinator they trust.

The parents and pediatric professionals act as partners in the medical home to identify and access all the medical and non-medical services needed to help children and their families reach their full potential.
